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# T.S. MISHRA UNIVERSITY

1. **Admission Eligibility:** Candidate should have passed 10+2 examinations, or its equivalent conducted by Boards/Councils established by State Government/Central Government. Ensure eligibility criteria (subjects, marks, age, and reservation) strictly follow NCAHP norms. Publish eligibility requirements clearly on the University website and admission brochure.

2. **Mode of Entry (Admission):**

2.1 **Fresh Entry:** As per the Notification and Directives of NCAHP (guidelines issued by NCAHP from time to time).

2.2 **Lateral Entry:** Lateral Entry as per NCAHP curriculum of the respective courses.

3. **Examination:** Annual system (for BPT and BOT) and for rest courses there shall be one main University Examination after the completion of each semester. Examinations will be 3 hours. The schedule of which shall be provided by the University.

4. **Attendance:** - Minimum Attendance Criteria to be eligible to appear for the final examination, students must fulfil the following attendance requirements:

- 75% attendance in Theory subjects
- 80% attendance in Skills Training (Practical) and Elective subjects.

5. **Internal Assessment:** As per the concern course curricula (Prescribed in concern course curricula). As per the concern course curricula (Prescribed in concern course curricula).

5.1 **Those programs require 20 marks as internal (For Example).**

b) Day to day performance/ Class test/ internal viva/ Demonstration	= 05 marks
c) Attendance	= 05 marks
<b>Total</b>	<b>= 30 marks</b>

**6. Question Paper Pattern:** On the platform of Bloom's Taxonomy with COs and BTL mapping. 10 (One word questions) + 4 (Short answer types with maximum 250 words) +3 (Long answer types questions with maximum 500 words).

**For Example, for University Theory Examination (80 Marks):**

- Duration: 3 Hours
- Maximum Marks: 80

Component	Pattern	Marks
Long Answer type Questions	Attempt all 3	3 × 15 = 45
Short Answer type Questions	Attempt all 3	3 × 5 = 15
True/False or Fill/one line answer	Attempt all 10	10 × 1 = 10

**For Example, for University Theory Examination (70 Marks):**

- Duration: 3 Hours
- Maximum Marks: 70

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## 7. Examiners Eligibility (Internal and External Examiners):

**7.1 UG Courses:** Should be minimum Assistant professor having PG with 2 years' Teaching / Research experience.

**8.1 Practical subjects examined per day:** Maximum two subjects of the semester / Year.

**8.2 Max students examined per examiner per day:** Not more than 50 students /subjects (Excluding Supplementary Students).

## 9. Promotional Rules:

**9.1** A student shall be declared pass in a semester when he/she is pass in all the theory and practical subjects.

**9.2** A student failing to satisfy the passing standards of one or more subjects in the semester shall be permitted to pursue course of the next semester and clear the back paper in the subsequent odd/even semester examination.

**9.3** Students shall be allowed to keep term for last semester if she/he passes in all heads of award the previous semester i.e. Semester I, Semester II, Semester III, IV, V, VI and Semester VII and so on.

**9.4** A student shall be eligible to undertake internship only when he/ she has cleared all the subjects of all the final and pre-final semester.

**9.5** For annual system he/she must pass 1st year, 2nd year, 3rd year and so on for appear in the final year examination. For annual system semester examination will be taken as per the university rule.

OR

Any specific guideline mentions in the NCAHP curriculum guideline.

**10. Grace Marks:** A student can be awarded 'Grace Marks' not exceeding a maximum 5 marks, in not more than one Theory subjects. The grace marks shall not be added to the aggregate marks.

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**11. Declaration of Result:** In an individual subject the minimum pass marks (including internal assessment) shall be 50% in theory and 50% in practical separately. The marks obtained in the University Examination and in the internal assessment of the subject shall be added to compute subject percentage.

**12. Award of Division:**

**12.1** His/her division shall be awarded on the basis of all Semester/Year result.

If a candidate passes all examinations overall in first attempt without grace and secures 75% or more marks, he/she shall be placed in 'First Division with distinction.

**12.2** If a candidate passes all examinations in first attempt and secures 60% or more marks, he/she shall be placed in First Division.

**13. Award of Degree:** The student shall be eligible for award of degree on successful completion of prescribed course of study i.e. he/ she must have been declared pass in result and completed compulsory Rotatory internship.

**14. Award of Rank:** On the basis of Final year result, the top three candidates shall be awarded rank according to their merit provided they pass all examinations in first attempt.

**15. Scrutiny and Re-evaluation:** Scrutiny and re-evaluation shall be as per university regulations.

**16. Unfair means:** All cases regarding reported use of Unfair Means will be disposed as per university regulations.

**17. Cancellation of Admission:** The admission of a student at any stage of study shall be cancelled if he/she is not found qualified as per norms and guidelines or the eligibility criteria prescribed by the University.

**18. Readmission:** "All re-admissions of students are Course to the approval of the Vice-Chancellor. Readmission is generally permitted only if the student can complete the total course within the maximum permitted duration (e.g., 4 years + 4years extended i.e. Nx2)."

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**19. Resource & Infrastructure Readiness:** Verify availability of qualified faculty, infrastructure, laboratories, and clinical tie-ups before approving intake.

- Ensure intake capacity strictly adheres to NCAHP-approved limits.
- Conduct orientation workshops for faculty and admission staff on NCAHP regulations and compliance requirements.

**20. Internship Programme:**

**Duration and Nature:** All students shall undergo a one-year (52 weeks) full-time Rotatory Internship Programme after successful completion of the academic requirements.

- **Internship Requirements**

**Total duration:** 12 months / 52 weeks (including public holidays and casual leave)  
Minimum working hours per week, total clinical hours and total credits allotted as mentioned in the NCAHP Curriculum of the respective program

- **Stipend:** The internship stipend shall be decided by the Institute management according to NCAHP Guideline.

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
