Genesis and Evolution of T.S. Mishra University, Lucknow

T.S. Mishra University, Lucknow was established under the T.S. Mishra University Act of 2019 as a U.P. State Private University of Uttar Pradesh. T.S. Mishra University, Lucknow was conceived with a thrust on creating a niche for itself and progressively achieve a World-class University status.

The T S Mishra University has been established as a memorial to the late Justice Tribeni Sahai Misra, whose commitment to Education inspired the founding members to create a Center of Excellence for Learning, Knowledge and Wisdom.

The late Justice Tribeni Sahai Misra was born on 15th November 1922 to a well-known family of Mahona, Lucknow. Being the eldest child and displaying a scientific aptitude very early in life, he completed his Intermediate Education in Science and Mathematics from the Government Jubilee College. He was married in the year 1940 to Dr. Shakuntala Misra in whose memory the State Government of Uttar Pradesh established a University for the specially abled. (The Dr. Shakuntala Misra National Rehabilitation University). While studying at Allahabad University he threw himself into the Quit India Movement of 1942 for which he was imprisoned in a cell having the Late Justice Yashdodandan a former Judge of the High Court as a cell mate. A year later, he graduated from the Allahabad University. He completed his post graduate studies with dual degrees of M.A. (English) and L.L.B with distinction from the University of Lucknow in the year 1945.A keen sportsman, he captained both the badminton and football teams of the University.

Given his legal acumen and professional knowledge, he was appointed as the District Government Counsel (D.G.C.) by the State Government in the year 1964 and subsequently was elevated as a Judge of the Allahabad High Court in the year 1971. He remained a Senior Judge at Lucknow Bench of Allahabad High Court and went on to become the Chief Justice of Guwahati High Court in 1983. Justice T. S. Misra also functioned as the Governor of Assam and Meghalaya. He, subsequently retired on 14 November 1984. In the year 1986 Justice Misra was appointed as the Ombudsman (Lok

Ayukta) Bihar. He finally retired from active service in 1991.
